PAYMENT PLAN & FORMS OF PAYMENT

The SJCC will charge a 3% service fee on all credit card and debit card transactions for both one-time and recurring charges. To avoid this service fee, you can choose to change your payment method to using ACH transactions, which will allow direct withdrawals from your bank account. You will make this selection at time of registration via CampDoc when you complete the "Camp Payment Preference" form. The "Camp Payment Preference Form" must be completed at time of registration.

All camp fees must be paid in full by the start of your camper's first day of camp or you must sign up for our payment plan for auto-draft payments. We will take your camper's total fees and deduct the deposit to find your balance. Your balance will be split into three equal payments that will be scheduled for the 1st of June, July and August*.

*If your camper will not attend camp on dates that fall in the month of August, payments will be scheduled for June 1 and July 1 only.

CHANGES, CANCELLATIONS & ADDITIONS

A **Change** occurs when a camper's number of weeks remains the same but their schedule changes.
(Changes are not guaranteed and are subject to availability in the program.)

A **Cancellation** occurs when a camper's number of weeks decreases (i.e., from 7 weeks to 5 weeks of camp).

Changes to programs, schedules, or additional options made after **May 23, 2025** will be subject to a \$15 administrative fee.

Cancellations for any reason will be processed as follows:

Before May 23, 2025 – Deposits will become a credit on your JCC account to use for other services at the JCC. All payments paid above the deposit are refundable.

Beginning May 24, 2025– Deposits are non-refundable. All payments paid above the deposit are refundable.

There are no refunds on credit card service fees.

Once a registered week begins, no refunds will be granted for cancellations.

There are no credits for unused times or absences.

When adding new weeks beyond the initial registration appropriate deposits will be charged and scheduled payments will be updated.

Registrations made after June 1st will need to provide deposit and first installment payment for services.

SCHOLARSHIPS & SUBSIDIES

Financial assistance is available depending on availability and need through the generosity of the Jewish Federation of Northeastern NY.

FOOD AT CAMP

Camp Chaverim will provide two daily snacks- one in the morning and one in the afternoon. All food that Camp will provide will be kosher and nut free. Campers will need to pack a daily lunch from home. There may be some camp groups that will be required to pack a nut-free lunch due to allergies.

Camp Chaverim offers fully supervised extended care programs in the morning and afternoon. Extended AM care is available as early as 7:30am. Extended PM care runs until 5:30pm each day. These programs are available with additional fees. Campers will have access to playgrounds, games, and more. There is no charge for drop off between 8:45-9:00am or pick up between 4:00-4:15pm. CAMP HOURS

DAILY SCHEDULE

Campers will participate in a variety of activities throughout the week. The camp day operates on a 45 minute block schedule. Each block will be assigned particular activity with many being led by our Camp Specialists. Camp Specialty areas include: Art, Sports, Drama, Nature, Science, Music, Cooking, Israeli culture & Archery. There will be assigned times for playground, GaGa, lunch & other unit activities such as kickball. There will be special events over the course of the summer that may change the schedule at times. Your campers group schedule will be made available before the start of summer.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Even though summer is filled with fun, safety is our number one priority. We take the care of your children seriously. Annually our camp is registered with the State of NY Health Department and is licensed as a Summer Day Camp. Our annual inspection ensures we are in compliance with all safety standards.

Camp Chaverim will have a Camp Nurse on-site during the camp day from 9am-4pm daily. In addition to having a trained medical professional our Camp Supervisory team are trained yearly and receive certifications in CPR, first aid & responding to emergencies.

CAMP SWIM PROGRAM

Campers will have access to our beautiful William & Estelle Golub Family Outdoor Pool and SplashPad here at the SJCC. Campers will go to outdoor pool daily.

Campers will have a daily 45 minute swim period that will either be Swim Lessons, Free Swim or Splash Pad each day.

Campers will receive two - 45 minute swim lessons each week. Groups will either have lessons on Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays. Families will receive schedules before the start of camp. Swim Lessons will align with the Red Cross Learn to Swim program led by certified swim instructors.

Swim Reports will be sent home at the end of Weeks 3, 6 & 8.



JEWISH PROGRAMMING

Camp at Schenectady JCC has been a tradition for more than 90 years. Throughout that time, SJCC has developed a strong program of themed activities steeped in Jewish Values.

SJCC uses the JCC Association's TAG curriculum. TAG is an acronym for Torah (learning and living), Avodah (service and spirituality), and Gemilut Chasadim (acts of loving kindness). Camp has selected values and each week Unit Heads will do fun and engaging activities based on the weekly theme. All of the units will focus on universal values that are important to all campers. Our Camp Chaverim Values will help reinforce the Jewish values that campers will learn about over the course of the summer.



We are also happy to be welcoming back Shlichim, emissaries of the Israeli community. They always bring unique perspectives and help make camp such a special experience. SJCC has hosted Shlichim for more than 20 years through Jewish Agency of Israel. This program offers an opportunity for campers to meet and get to know young Israelis and learn about their home and life in Israel.

Every Friday we end our camp week all together as a camp as we celebrate with Oneg Shabbat!

Our Counselor-in-Training (CIT) Programs are for energetic and motivated teenagers entering 9th or 10th Grade who want to learn and develop leadership skills working with children in a camp setting, while still getting to enjoy all the fun activities and friendships of summer camp. CITs/LITs train through a proven program that includes direct supervision, regular guidance with senior staff, and hands-on experiences engaging with campers.
