DAILY SCHEDULE

Campers will participate in a variety of activities throughout the week. The camp day operates on a 45 minute block schedule. Each block will be assigned a particular activity with many being led by our Camp Specialists. Camp Specialty areas include: Art, Sports, Drama, Nature, Science, Music, Cooking, Israeli culture & Archery. There will be assigned times for playground, GaGa, lunch & other unit activities such as kickball. There will be special events over the course of the summer that may change the schedule at times. Your campers group schedule will be made available before the start of summer.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Even though summer is filled with fun, safety is our number one priority. We take the care of your children seriously. Annually our camp is registered with the State of NY Health Department and is licensed as a Summer Day Camp. Our annual inspection ensures we are in compliance with all safety standards.

Camp Chaverim will have a Camp Nurse on-site during the camp day from 9am-4pm daily. In addition to having a trained medical professional our Camp Supervisory team are trained yearly and receive certifications in CPR, first aid & responding to emergencies.

CAMP SWIM PROGRAM

Campers will have access to our beautiful William & Estelle Golub Family Outdoor Pool and SplashPad here at the SJCC. Campers will go to outdoor pool daily.

Campers will have a daily 45 minute swim period that will either be Swim Lessons, Free Swim or Splash Pad each day.

Campers will receive two - 45 minute swim lessons each week. Groups will either have lessons on Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays. Families will receive schedules before the start of camp. Swim Lessons will align with the Red Cross Learn to Swim program led by certified swim instructors.

JEWISH PROGRAMMING

Camp at Schenectady JCC has been a tradition for more than 90 years. Throughout that time, SJCC has developed a strong program of themed activities steeped in Jewish Values.

SJCC uses the JCC Association's TAG curriculum. TAG is an acronym for Torah (learning and living), Avodah (service and spirituality), and Gemilut Chasadim (acts of loving kindness). Camp has selected values and each week Unit Heads will do fun and engaging activities based on the weekly theme. All of the units will focus on universal values that are important to all campers. Our Camp Chaverim Values will help reinforce the Jewish values that campers will learn about over the course of the summer.



We are also happy to be joined by one of our local Shinshinim through the Jewish Federation. A Shinshinim spends the entire year in the Capital Region. They will join camp as our Camp Israeli Culture Specialist. This program offers an opportunity for campers to meet and get to know young Israelis and learn about their home and life in Israel. The highlight of everyone's week is when all of camp come together to celebrate Oneg Shabbat!

FOOD AT CAMP

Campers will need to pack a daily lunch from home. There may be some camp groups that will be required to pack a nut-free lunch due to allergies.

FIELD TRIPS

Campers will enjoy visiting local attractions and exploring different places of interest. Past summers have included trips to Albany Indoor Rockgym, Saratoga Ninja Lab, Lake George attractions and more! Most day campers will depart the JCC between 9:30-10:30am and will return by 3pm.

EXTENDED DAY FIELD TRIPS

There will be a few extended day trips scheduled for the upcoming summer - so we could add some trips a little further away, but not feel rushed to make it back to the JCC. Some of these trips may involve a departure from the JCC before 9:00a and they may get back to the JCC after 4:00p. You will be aware of all pickup and drop off times ahead of schedule. There will be no additional fees for early drop off or later pickup determined by the JCC.

J Days are days on site at the JCC that can be spent enjoying traditional camp activities with specialists, swimming or working on some Camp Mitzvahs (good deeds) where campers will work together to help others. Our Counselor-in-Training (CIT) Programs are for energetic and motivated teenagers who need to be 15 years old by 6/29/26 who want to learn and develop leadership skills working with children in a camp setting, while still getting to enjoy all the fun activities and friendships of summer camp. CITs train through a proven program that includes direct supervision, regular guidance with senior staff, and hands-on experiences engaging with campers.



All participants will have to provide two recommendation forms before start of program. Forms will be sent out to participants as summer approaches.

A CIT orientation will be held before the start of summer.

TYPICAL DAY

CITs will be assigned to a camp group to work with for the program. They will have the opportunity to select what age groups they would feel most comfortable working with. Monday through Thursday they will spend the AM with their camp groups and then after lunch join the CIT Director for a mix of learning, discussions, etc. On Fridays they will spend the entire day with their camp group.

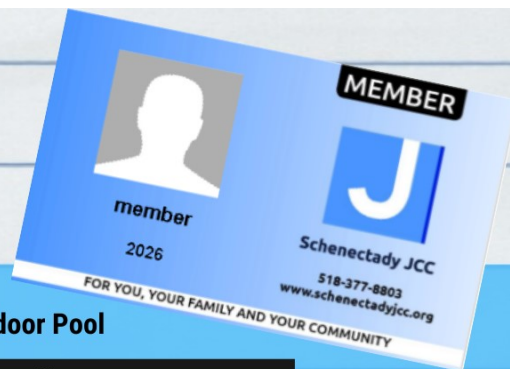

CHANGES, CANCELLATIONS & ADDITIONS

A **Change** occurs when a camper's number of weeks remains the same but their schedule changes.
(Changes are not guaranteed and are subject to availability in the program.)

A **Cancellation** occurs when a camper's number of weeks decreases (i.e., from 7 weeks to 5 weeks of camp).

Changes to programs, schedules, or additional options made after **May 22, 2026** will be subject to a \$15 administrative fee.

Cancellations for any reason will be processed as follows:

Before May 22, 2026 – Deposits will become a credit on your JCC account to use for other services at the JCC. All payments paid above the deposit are refundable.

Beginning May 23, 2026– Deposits are non-refundable. All payments paid above the deposit are refundable.

There are no refunds on credit card service fees.

Once a registered week begins, no refunds will be granted for cancellations.

There are no credits for unused times or absences.

When adding new weeks beyond the initial registration appropriate deposits will be charged and scheduled payments will be updated.

Registrations made after June 1st will need to provide deposit and first installment payment for services.
