



CAMPUS DIRECTOR'S REPORT

FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS

- ~ Renovated Men's Indoor Locker Room Showers
- ~ Constructed 30 foot Yurt for use during camp
 - ~ Purchased Pickleball Machine
 - ~ Stained front entryway of William & Estelle Golub Pool & Tennis Club
 - ~ Renewed Cedar Shakes on JCC Building
 - ~ Replaced antiquated pipes in boiler room

FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUED

- Constructed a new camp pavilion in memory of Mike Palahnuk
 - ~ Replaced and upgraded 64 sprinkler heads throughout facility
 - ~ Enhanced the Yurt structure by adding electricity and ceiling fan
- ~ Modernized five (5) pieces of fitness equipment
- ~ Installed new flooring in Weinberg Wing Hallway, Break Room and Farber-Miness Lounge

SJCC IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

- ~ 75,554 Check-ins with the Sports & Wellness desk and Pool & Tennis Club (8% increase over 2023)
- ~ 4261 active members as of 6.9.2025
- ~105 tours conducted with potential new members
- ~ 66% of tours resulted in a membership
 - ~ 533 unique campers in 2024

SJCC IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

- ~ 334 returning & 145 new campers in Camp Chaverim
- ~ 2743 total camper weeks in 2024
- ~ 96 staff & 12 CITs employed at Camp Chaverim
 - ~ 33 camp staff attended as a camper themselves
 - ~ 54 Galgalim campers in 2024

SJCC IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

- ~ 12 Israeli teens participated with Galgalim
 - ~ 38 Blue Wave Swim Team Members
- ~ 96 Hours the Sports & Wellness/Aquatics Departments are open each week
- ~ ~ 240 Personal Training Registrations in 2024
 - ~ 2000 Registrations for Pickleball in 2024

SJCC IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

~9 International, awardwinning films were screened at the Schenectady Jewish Film Festival

- ~ 10 Jewish holiday Art Displays to welcome and educate about the traditions of each holiday
 - ~ 6 Jewish Holidays were celebrated
 - ~ 1 Live Readings program with Leiah Bowden
 - ~ 3 Cooking classes for seniors

SJCC IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

- ~ 1600 hot Kosher meals were served at the Senior Lunch Program
- ~ 100 weekly Ceramic Open Studio sessions
 - ~ 1 New ECE Director, Remy Cohen
 - ~ 124 ECE students
- ~ 7 Baby goat visitors on our "Kibbutz" during the Imaginary Trip to Israel
 - ~ 1 Driver Safety Refresher course

SJCC IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

- ~ 5th Annual Summer Art Festival & Craft Fair
- ~ 2,895 Dollars raised by ECE fundraisers for the PTO
- ~ 7069 Diaper changes logged onto Brightwheel, ECE's parent communication app

 - ~ 52 new families participated in Kids Time & ASEP programs






Mike Palahnuk

Barry was reelected in 2003 and was later elected as a justice on New York's State Supreme Court in 2009. He retired in 2018.
