Services Offered

By completing a Caregiver Assessment, caregivers will share details about their situation and what their short-term and long-term goals are. We have respite grants available (contracts with home care agencies, a partnership with Consumer Directed Choices, Inc., contracts with day programs, and contracts with facilities to offer overnight respite stays). We contract with several elder law attorneys to provide a FREE one-hour legal consult for the purpose of long-term planning. Our Volunteer Care Teams do not provide hands-on or more medical support but offer friendly visits and short respite for the families we serve. We partner with the Alzheimer's Association to provide different educational programming and support groups. We offer Memory Mixers which are joint enrichment events for, both, caregivers and their care partners. We have a Caregiver Wellness Club that facilitates a virtual book club, a walking club, a coffee club, virtual crafts, in-person events. We have some funding for home medical equipment and Mom's Meals food delivery. We refer families to Community Medicaid – MLTC or NHTD and also to different Certified Senior Housing Advisors. Our Care Management services are for people who are living alone and have a formal diagnosis of some form of dementia.

Criteria for Services

Care Navigation – no formal diagnosis is required. If a person is exhibiting signs and symptoms of dementia then their caregiver/s qualify for our services. We cannot duplicate services
